Tuberous Sclerosis Complex [TSC] is a genetic disorder that affects people in many different ways and with differing degrees of severity.

TSC affects hundreds of individuals in New Zealand and thousands more carers, families and friends who live with the impact of the condition.

TSC tumours can grow in any organ of the body, commonly affecting the brain, skin, heart, lungs and kidneys. There is no cure for TSC, but with appropriate support people with TSC can live fulfilling lives.

How does TSC affect lives?

Although TSC affects everyone living with the condition differently, common problems include:



Difficult to control seizures



Developmental delay



Autism



Behavioural and learning difficulties



Sleep problems



Kidney problems
